And we his face shall see

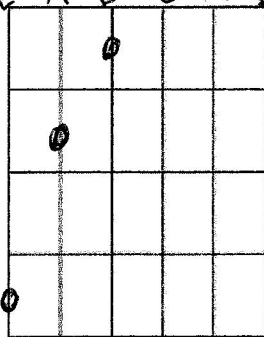

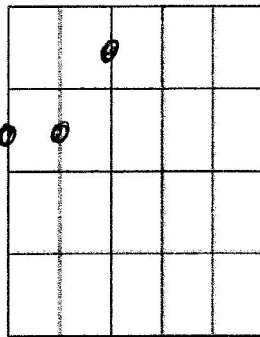

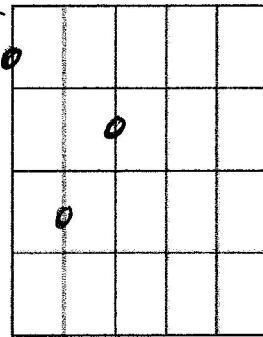
